IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE ISSUE OF FLU VACCINES 2018/2019

This year there are 3 different types of flu vaccine

- 6mts 2yrs if "at risk" Nasal (Fluenz)
- Preschool children (born between 2/7/14 1/9/16 Nasal (Fluenz)
 (Note: School age children will be vaccinated in school)
- 18yrs 64yrs "at Risk" patients Intramuscular (QiV)
- 65yrs + Intramuscular (aTIV) (Fluad)

Due to supply restrictions which are beyond our control we have been asked to prioritise and call **patients who are 75yrs and above first** and organise our clinics accordingly.

Patients aged 65yrs – 74yrs <u>will</u> be vaccinated with Fluad <u>once further stocks are available</u>. These patients will not be offered an alternative vaccine.

Therefore we are organising our clinics in the following way -

Wednesday 10th October - Patients over 75yrs

(2pm – 5pm) Patients 18yrs – 64yrs "at risk"

Pre-school children

Wednesday 24th October - Remainder over > 75yrs (allowing for supply)

(2pm – 5pm) Patients > 65 yrs – 74 yrs (allowing for supply)

Patients 18yrs - 64yrs "at risk"

Pre-school children who haven't received a vaccination.

Please be patient with us as will be allocated specific numbers of vaccines in October November and December and will not be issued vaccines in excess of this.
